

March, 2024 Minutes

Principal Update

- Lake Huron Family of Parishes Update
 - monthly school Masses have been scheduled for next year
 - monthly Youth Masses will also soon be determined
 - 20 Gr 2 & 3 students recently trained as altar servers
- EQAO was administered May 21-31 for all students in Gr 3 & 6
 - followed similar online model as last year
- Grad being held at the church on Tuesday June 18 (liturgy, graduation ceremony) at 5:30
 - refreshments will be provided afterward using Healthy Snack funds
- review of school dress code which will be included in PBS Handbook for 2024-25 school year *no revisions recommended
 - Shirts/Tops no inappropriate messages; nothing that reveals the midriff, breasts or navel; no spaghetti straps (straps at least 5 cm in width); if sleeveless, clothing is to fit snugly around the shoulder and under the armpits
 - Pants/Skirts will not be worn so low as to reveal underclothing or buttocks; skirts and shorts must be a minimum of mid-thigh in length
 - Hats/Caps/Hoods are not to be worn in the school at any time, except for special "Hat
 - Footwear pupils must wear properly fitted shoes while in school

Spring BBQ Debrief

- BBQ 2024 notes
 - held Wednesday June 5 from 4:30-6:00
 - prefer to be held before May long weekend in future
 - church venue was excellent use of oven, rain or shine, use of kitchen (freezer, fridge)
 - very helpful to the ticket legend for parents and volunteers
 - 37 treasure table items
 - good that draw time for treasure table was advertised
 - great to have names of students pre printed on the tickets
 - use of oven and foil pans allowed us to cook ahead and keep things warm
 - very helpful having buns out of bags
 - started BBQing at 4:00.
 - 1 runner, 1 at BBQ, 1 at ticket table, 3 serving food & cupcakes
 - jug of water (w ice) with paper cups (no access to refill water station)
 - 2 bottles of ketchup (1/2 leftover)
 - 2 bottles of mustard (1/2 leftover)
 - 2 jars relish (1 jar leftover)
 - bag of diced onions
 - napkins, foil pans, tinfoil, paper cups
 - total paid on School Cash = \$825, total cost of all items = \$613
 - profit of \$212 which can be used to start up BBQ for next year, offset any increase in prices or be donated

 - total ordered in school cash online
 - 116 hot dogs
 - 113 precooked burgers
 - 150 cupcakes
 - purchase price at cost
 - hot dog \$2.60
 - hamburger \$3.60
 - cupcake \$1.05

<u>Fundraisers</u>

- able to hold 2 fundraisers per school year and must have a plan for funds first
- this year
 - Chocolate factory fundraiser total raised \$1153.87
 - Christmas \$597.32
 - Easter \$556.55
 - Huron Ridge total raised \$970.15
 - Christmas \$700.15
 - Spring \$270.00
 - \$2124.02 total annual funds raised
- last year (2022-23)
 - Greyhaven Gardens total raised \$1057
 - Christmas fundraiser raised \$641
 - Spring fundraiser raised \$416
 - Chocolate Factory fundraiser raised \$1232
 - \$2289 total annual funds raised

Approved Expenditures

- \$546.16 pizza for Open House
- provide \$200 to each teacher to support field trips, guest speakers (13 teachers including itinerants and SERT = \$2600) - will use hot lunch funds
- \$350 Grad (\$25/grad = \$25 x 14) will use hot lunch funds
- \$3000 padded volleyball posts and net used \$338.06 from hot lunch program to cover balance over \$3000)
- \$310 BBQ start up will use council funds (carried forward from last year's BBQ)
